

FAQs for RACE Junior Programme

Q1: What is RACE Junior's June Holidays 4-Days Coding Camp?

Race Junior's June Holidays 4-Days Coding Camp is a 4-days programme held during the June Holidays period, with each day lasting 3.5 hours.

The Coding Camp consists of 2 programmes:

- i. 4-Days **Minecraft** Coding Camp*
- ii. 4-Days **micro:bit** Coding Camp*

Q2: What are the programme dates for the 4 Days micro:bit Coding Camp?

Programme dates for 4-Days micro:bit Coding Camp are as follows:

1	Monday - Thursday (2:00pm – 5:30pm): 30 th May 2022 – 2 nd June 2022	Programme fee: \$380/student <i>(not inclusive of micro:bit hardware)</i>
2	Monday - Thursday (2:00pm – 5:30pm): 13 th June 2022 – 16 th June 2022	micro:bit Programme Kit fee: \$48

- i. Slots are based on first come first served basis and are subjected to availability.*
- ii. Purchase of micro:bit Programme Kit is compulsory for students without micro:bit V2 and above.*
- iii. Enjoy \$50 off on Programme Fees for every 2 sign-ups.*

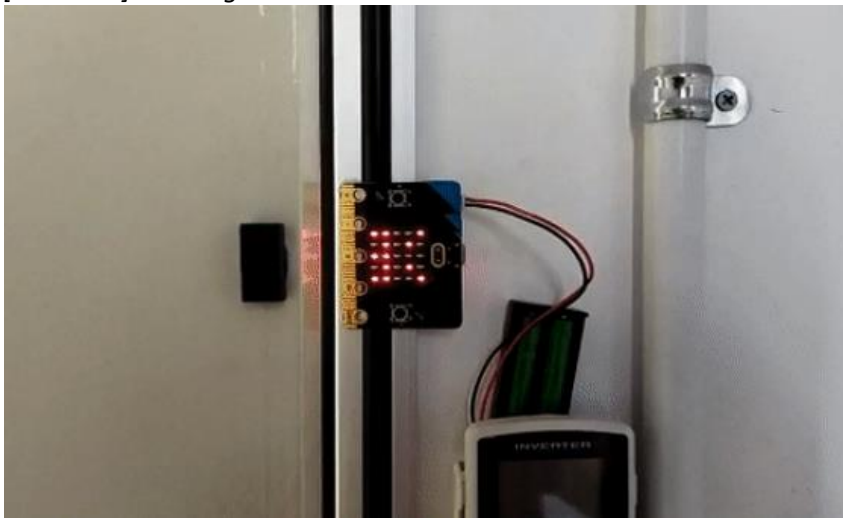


Q3: What will my child learn from the programme?

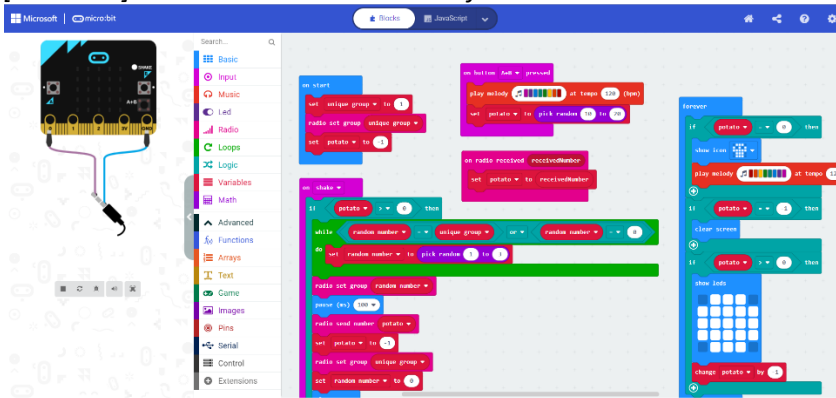
During the 4-Days **micro:bit** Coding Camp, your child will learn to program the micro:bit using MakeCode. Learners will be able to program various interactive games such as creating their own version of Flappy Bird & Snake Game! Throughout the Coding camp, they will also receive an in-depth knowledge on how the little robotic device can sense light, movement, temperature, sound and much more!

Q4: What are the eligibility criteria for enrolling my child?

*The 4-Days **micro:bit** Coding Camp is designed for children between 7 – 12 years old. However, for children between 7-9 years old we would recommend adult companion at least on the first day of the Coding Camp to facilitate their learning. A maximum of 1 adult companion is allowed per student.*

Q5: What is the average class size?

Our average class size is 5-8 students. However, a minimum of 5 students will be required to start the class.

Q6: Where will the classes be conducted?

Classes will be conducted on-site at The Commerze @ Irving (1 Irving Place, Singapore 369546). Exact details of the location will be disclosed upon enrolment confirmation.

Q7: Can I sit in the programme and accompany my child?

Adult companion is only recommended for younger students between 7 – 9 years old. A maximum of 1 adult companion is allowed per student

Q8: How can I pick up my child after lessons?

Parents may wait at the entrance located outside of the classroom to pick up their child after lessons.

Q9: Will my child be able to get a replacement lesson if they are absent?

With a valid Medical Certificate provided, make up lessons can only be arranged for students if the next class is available. Alternatively, you may opt to 'keep the credits' for the next programme booking.

Our lessons are designed in such that each day will get more challenging. Hence, we strongly encourage our students to attend all lessons in order to have them stay on track.

Q10: Will I get a refund on the nett fees if I withdraw my child from the programme?

In the event that a student decides to withdraw from the programme after fees are paid, the programme fees paid shall be forfeited. No refunds or pro-rate of programme fees will be provided for missed lessons.

Q11: What certification will my child receive upon the completion of the programme?

A Certificate of Completion will be awarded to students who meet a minimum of 75% of the attendance. The Certificate of Completion will be issued within 30 days from the completion of the programme. The Certificate of Completion will not be provided if the student withdraws from the programme prior to completion.

Q12: What else will be provided during the programme?

Snacks and drinks will be provided during the programme. For the safety of your child, please declare in the application form and let us know in advance if your child has any food allergy or conditions that we should take note of.

Q13: What does my child need to bring for classes?

*Students attending 4-Days **micro:bit** Coding Camp are required to bring:*

- i. **Water bottle***
- ii. **Writing materials** (optional)*
- iii. **Jacket** (optional)*
- iv. **Laptop** with at least one working USB port, can connect to Wi-Fi and have access to an internet browser & a **computer mouse***
- v. **Micro:bit Programme kit** (will be issued to the student on the 1st day if it was purchased from us.)*
